### Club Formation

STAR Soccer Club was created in the spring of 2003 by combining the operations of three soccer clubs: Finneytown Soccer Club, Winton United, and Wyoming Soccer Club. STAR SC now offers a full range of opportunities for youth soccer players in the **S**pringfield **T**ownship **A**rea of Hamilton County. This includes the communities of Wyoming, Finneytown, Greenhills, Forest Park, Woodlawn, Springdale, Glendale, College Hill, North College Hill, Mt. Healthy, and more.

### Competition

STAR Soccer Club is a member of Ohio South Youth Soccer and teams compete within the Cincinnati United Soccer League (CUSL.) Our top teams seek even more challenging competition through participation in the Buckeye Premier League and/or The Premier League of CUSL. In addition, many of our teams seek to enhance their opportunities through participation in a variety of tournaments both locally and regionally each season. Every fall STAR SC serves as the host of the Forest Park Invitational, Cincinnati's oldest continuing youth soccer tournament.

### Where is STAR Soccer Club?

STAR Soccer Club operates primarily in the Winton Road corridor from I-275 south to North Bend Rd. We have use agreements with the city of Forest Park, Springfield Township, Winton Woods School District, Wyoming School District, Lockland Schools and St Xavier High School. These agreements allow us access to a large number of facilities for both games and training and our tournament, the Forest Park Invitational. STAR SC's access to several turf facilities provides us some of the best training and game options in the area.

### Game Fields

**Winton Woods HS Stadium**-the turf field serves as the primary game field for our U15-U18 teams.

**Springfield Township Center (Grove)**-this grass field serves as the home for our U11-U12 teams.

**Stephanie Hummer Park**-these grass fields serve as the home for our U8-U10 teams. It is also used as a secondary site for U13-U14 teams.

### Training Fields

**Winton Woods Middle School Campus**-this serves as the primary training home for ALL STAR SC teams. There are 3 full fields and 2 practice areas laid out that can accommodate as many as 15 teams at one time. In addition, the stadium provides lighted training opportunities which offers a very unique opportunity and allows the club to offer training times to even more teams. Winton Woods HS-this lighted, turf facility is used by each of our U15 and older teams at least once a week for practices. As many as 6 teams per night can utilize this facility.
